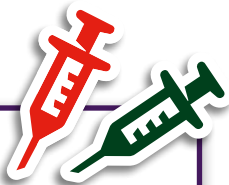
The flu epidemic lasted

are constantly changing.

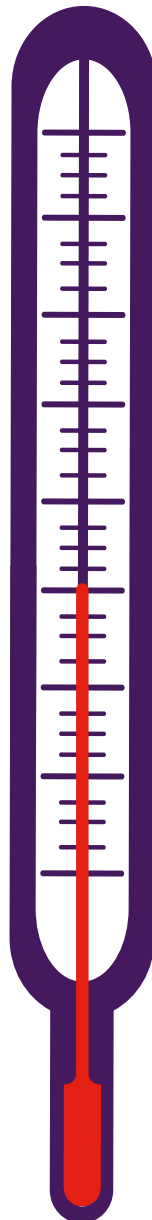
EFFECTIVENESS

The 2016 flu vaccine was moderate
effective against the flu strain that
most circulated this winter.



500,000 PATIENTS

had symptomatic influenza in the
period between the beginning of
October until the end of May.

Many people were admitted to
hospital with flu complications,
such as pneumonia.



FLU VACCINE

About half of the people who were
eligible to receive a flu vaccination
were vaccinated against flu.

more people than

associated with the flu epidemic.
