Re: Test result bowel cancer screening programme

You recently took part in the national screening programme for bowel cancer.

What was the test result?

Your test results are favourable.

Your screening indicates that there is no need for you to go to hospital for a further examination.

How reliable is the test result?

The screening is a snapshot and does not provide complete certainty. There is still a chance that you may have bowel cancer or may develop it in the future. You will receive an invitation for screening every two years. You will not receive an invitation if you reach the age of 75 within the next two years.

What should you do?

Stay alert for symptoms such as blood in your stool or a persistent change in the pattern of your bowel movements, such as constipation or diarrhoea. Are you currently experiencing any such symptoms? Please contact your GP and do not wait for an invitation for the screening programme.
