DOWNLOAD

To install Storybuilder Lite 2.3.0.11 on your computer, download the following files from the download application:

INSTALLATION

Install the software by running SetupStoryBuilderv2.3.0.11.exe. The installation directory should contain the following files:

File	Description
StoryBuilderv2.3.0.11.exe	The actual Storybuilder program
Blank.sb	Database needed by Storybuilder.
ChangeHistory.xls	Changes since last release.
SB Program Data.mdb	Database needed for program settings.
Storybuilder.chm	Storybuilder helpfile (in English) that opens from within the Storybuilder program or can be opened stand alone. If it does not open within the program or by double clicking on the file itself, right click on the file in the program directory, choose Properties from the download menu and give the computer permission to open it.
zzzzzz.sb	Database needed by Storybuilder.

Unzip "Databases v14 121207v4 REV1.zip" and place the databases "14 CREATIONS MOTHER SUPERFILE 121207v4_ANONa.sb" and "14 CREATIONS MOTHER SUPERFILE 121207v4_BLANK.sb" in the installation directory.

Start the program. Choose Expert or Lite version. Open a database by using the *Open button* in the *Database menu*, see the Storybuilder Overview section at the beginning of the Help file. Storybuilder will create a tmp file in a directory, which may lead to errors if you do not have access rights to that directory. Thus the database may not open the first time. This can be fixed by changing the temp file location in the *Mode & Settings menu*.
