Re: Result from breast cancer screening

Dear Madam,

You took part in the breast cancer screening programme on ... [Datum onderzoek].

What was the result?

We did **not** find any signs of breast cancer on the X-rays.

How reliable is the result?

The result does not provide absolute certainty that you do not have breast cancer, as not all suspicious abnormalities are found on the X-rays. Three out of 10 cases of breast cancer are not detected. Also, we can only gauge the situation at present, not whether you might contract breast cancer at some time in the future.

What should I do?

Stay on the lookout for any changes in your breasts and phone your GP if you notice any. Do not wait until the next screening programme. Further details are available at www.bevolkingsonderzoekborstkanker.nl.

When will I be invited again?

You will be sent a fresh invitation in two years' time. The population screening programme is for all women aged between 50 to 75. After you reach the age of 76 you will receive no further invitations.
