Dear Ms Doe,

You participated in the screening for cervical cancer.

## What is the result?

HPV (human papilloma virus) has been detected in your smear test. No abnormal cells have been detected.

## What does this mean?

There are no indications that you have cervical cancer or a preliminary stage of it.

HPV has been detected. HPV is a virus that may change the cells in your cervix. Therefore, it is important that you have another smear test performed. You will receive an invitation for a smear test in six months. We will then check whether the cells still look normal. This control smear test is free.
