Dear Ms Doe,

You participated in the screening for cervical cancer.

## What is the result?

HPV (human papilloma virus) has been detected in your smear test. The smear test also detected mildly abnormal cells.

## What does this mean?

There are no indications that you have cervical cancer or a preliminary stage of it. Because mild abnormalities have been detected, it is recommended that you have the gynaecologist examine you further.

## Follow-up examination at the gynaecologist

Contact your family doctor to discuss this result. The family doctor will refer you to the gynaecologist. The gynaecologist will perform a follow-up examination to find out whether treatment is necessary.
