Re: the result of the breast cancer screening examination

Dear Ms,

You took part in the breast cancer screening programme on [date screening].

What was the result?

We did **not** find any signs of breast cancer on the X-rays.

How reliable is the result?

This result does not completely rule out the possibility of breast cancer. Not all abnormalities are detected in the screening programme. Three out of ten cases of breast cancer are not identified. Also, we can only gauge the situation at present, not whether you might contract breast cancer at some time in the future.

What should you do?

Stay on the lookout for any changes in your breasts. If you notice changes in your breast(s), please visit your GP. Do not wait until the next screening invitation.

When will you be invited again?

You will receive another invitation in two years. The population screening programme is for all women aged between 50 to 75. After you reach the age of 76 you will receive no further invitations.
