This letter is your invitation to get a COVID-19 vaccination. Invitations will be sent to everyone aged 70 and over this year. This vaccination will offer you better protection against serious illness due to COVID-19. It is up to you to decide if you want to be vaccinated. The COVID-19 vaccination is free of charge.

How to make an appointment

- Please schedule an appointment by 27 November at the latest by visiting planjeprik.nl/afspraak. The Municipal Public Health Services (GGDs) will start administering vaccinations from 21 September.
- Visit planjeprik.nl to make an appointment. You will need your DigiD.
- If you do not have a DigiD yet, call the GGD call centre during office hours on 0800-7070. You will need your citizen service number (BSN).
- Would you like to have an appointment at the same time as someone else? See www.planjeprik.nl/afspraak for more information.
- After making an appointment, the GGD will send you an e-mail to confirm. Read it carefully, because it contains important information about the appointment.

Vaccinating at home: only if medically necessary

If a serious illness, disorder or disability prevents you from going to a vaccination centre on your own or with assistance, it is possible to receive the COVID-19 vaccination at home. Call 0800-7070 to arrange this.

Do you live in a residential care facility?

If you live in a residential care facility, you will get the COVID-19 vaccination there. Your facility will let you know more.
